UBEA RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Provo High School Dancesport is recognized by the NDCA. We will abide by rules and regulations governing competitions and championships recognized by the National Dance Council of America, Inc. Some of the NDCA rules that directly apply to amateur competitors, along with additional rules applied by the organizer follow:

- 1. ALL COMPETITORS AND SPECTATORS must purchase an admission ticket for each day they are attending.
- 2. No couple is exempt from competing in any round. Any couple who fails to appear at the scheduled time for the first round of any event will be disqualified from the event.
- 3. No person may compete in an age classification lower than their own. A couple's age classification eligibility is defined as the year in school at the time of the event.

Age Category Classifications

Participation in the syllabus events is based upon the current grade in school of the competitor according to the following designations: Elementary School = $K - 6^{th}$ Grade

Junior High School = $7^{th} - 9^{th}$ Grade

High School = $10^{th} - 12^{th}$ Grade

Entry Restrictions

- 1. Pre-teen, Junior and Youth competitors who dance a Championship or Open event may not dance in the Syllabus event of the same style.
- 2. Elementary and Junior High competitors may dance up one division only in each competition category.
- 3. All international style syllabus competitions are restricted to the ISTD Bronze, Silver and Gold. Newcomer and American style syllabus events may use any syllabus from member organizations of the NDCA as well as the BYU syllabus. They are restricted to Bronze & Silver figures, elements and restrictions. Couples must dance within the framework of the accepted syllabi, including precedes & follows, & without embellishment. Figures must be danced as defined in the ISTD technique books. Partial figures may not be utilized unless so specified in the "precedes & follows" sections. No syncopations of steps may be used unless specified in a syllabus. Couples dancing out of syllabus will be warned once & then disqualified.
- 4. <u>Guidelines for Newcomer</u>: A competitor is eligible to dance in the "Newcomer" event (Elementary, Junior High, High School) IF: a dancer has been dancing for less than 18 months AND/OR until they have placed in a final of any syllabus event in their age classification, provided a quarterfinal was danced. **Open competitors are NOT allowed to compete Newcomer**. Additionally couples who enter the youth "Newcomer" and "Syllabus" event may not enter any Adult event in that same style. Likewise, no Newcomer competitor may dance in any Open category.
- 5. A competitor is eligible to dance in "Newcomer" event until they place in the Final at the BYU event each semester. BYU in Nov. and March will be the last time each semester that will decide eligibility for this event.

Dress and/or Costuming

BOYS:

TROUSERS: a) Black only b) High waist optional c) Underfoot strap optional d) Satin stripes are allowed

SHIRTS: a) Plain white long sleeved collared shirt only b) No pleats or ribbing c) Sleeves to be worn at wrist length

MATERIALS: a) Fabrics must be plain, ie: cotton, polyester, cotton/polyester blend, wool blend b) No shiny fabrics c) No glitter, metallic thread, patterns or sequins allowed d) Decorations - not allowed

VESTS: a) Sweaters and vests NOT allowed.

TIE: a) Black color only, may be either straight or bow.

SOCKS: a) Black only. **SHOES:** No restrictions **MAKEUP:** Not allowed.

HAIRSTYLE: Long hair must be worn in a pony tail.

GIRLS:

Skirt with top or simple dress with attached under garment or leotard top with full skirt

SKIRTS: a) Plain or pleated with minimum 1 to maximum 3 half circles. One simple underskirt allowed which is no larger or longer than top layer b) No use of boning, frills, splits, openings, fishing line, etc c) Length of skirt must be at least knee length.

NECKLINES: a) Boat, high neck, v-neck, sweetheart, 'peter pan' collar, scoop and regular collar are allowed.

SLEEVES: are required a) Long, short, elbow length, cap, or puff are allowed b) cannot be replaced by trimmings, frills, or edging on the shoulder line. c) No "finger loops" allowed

MATERIALS: a) Fabrics *MUST* be only one color throughout. b) No glitter, metallic thread, or fabric creating 'light or pattern effects'. c) No use of feathers, fringes, bows, belts, frills or sequins d) No flesh color fabric e) Any use of color coordinated 'see through' fabric must be lined from waist to shoulder; for use on arms no lining is needed.

SHOES: No restrictions. MUST HAVE HEEL GUARDS!

SOCKS: a) White ankle socks or hose or fishnet tights.

OTHER: a) No use of arm bands, chokers or headbands. b) No decoration is allowed on dress or in hair. c) No jewelry is allowed other than one small earring in each ear. d) basic makeup allowed for elementary girls. e) Competition make up is allowed for Junior High and High School girls.

COSTUMES AND HEELGUARDS WILL BE CHECKED THROUGHOUT THE COMPETITION.
